The team held their annual training day on Sunday 20th October 2013 at Whitecliff Off-road Driving Centre. Over 20 volunteers from GW4x4R worked alongside colleagues from St John's Ambulance and Raynet to complete various scenario-based exercises including; recovery of a stalled car in a shallow flood, recovery of a stuck vehicle on an off-road track, first at the scene of a crashed car with an injured passenger, and a wheel change on soft terrain.



The afternoon saw some off road tuition from Whitecliff's BORDA instructors around one of



their courses. Heavy rain overnight had led to very muddy and challenging conditions. Members also led presentations to their team mates on winching and recovery equipment.

The day was an excellent opportunity to practise our off-road , team-working and communication skills before the winter arrives, and fun was had by all.
