



## **GW4x4R EQUIPMENT LIST**

### **MANDATORY EQUIPMENT**

#### Issue kit

1. Team Hi Viz jacket, Hi Viz waistcoat, Hi Viz event coat, Water proof trousers.
2. Identity Card.
3. Glove box Handbook.
4. In car VHF radio, with aerial.

#### Non-Issue kit

5. Notepad and pencil, Permanent marker pen.
6. Up to date contact list, Incident Report Sheet, Event Sign On Sheet, Risk Assessment Form, Expense Sheet.
7. OS maps of our area (Landranger series 150, 162, 163).
8. Compass.
9. Street maps of your local areas (Glos, Chelt, Worcester).
10. Sat nav system
11. Fire Extinguisher – at least 1 kg.
12. First Aid Kit (for personal use ).
13. Blanket (silver foil type acceptable).
14. Torch, spare batteries and bulbs.
15. Wellies and/or sturdy boots.
16. Change of clothing (we may be working late at night in the wet and cold). Binbags for any wet clothes.
17. Work Gloves – Surgical type and heavy duty rigger type (for personal protection).
18. Tool Kit – as basic as a set of screwdrivers, spanners, and a hammer. Also gaffer tape and cable ties.
19. Jump Leads
20. Recovery Strops, rated – one long and one short to give flexibility in recovery situations, min 4 tonne breaking strain (eg 2 tonne SWL with a 7:1 safety factor will meet this requirement).
21. Normal tow rope.
22. Shackles, rated, suited to the type & number of straps carried.
23. Rear recovery point, (eg JATE rings, NATO hitch or tow bar).
24. Saw – Bow saw or similar.
25. Amber Lights for increased vehicle visibility.
26. Snow shovel



## **SUGGESTED EQUIPMENT**

1. Recovery bridle, to minimise stresses on your vehicle under recovery situations.
2. Front secure recovery point. Lashing points are not acceptable.
3. If your vehicle has a winch fitted, the winch cable or rope must be in good condition, it is recommended that you also carry a snatch block and a winch blanket.
4. Hazard warning triangle.
5. Emergency window hammer / seat belt cutter.
6. Spare tyre, jack & tyre iron.
7. Food & drink.
8. Sunglasses – for snow/sun glare.
9. Spare oil, windscreen wash & radiator fluid, car bulbs for your car, jump leads.
10. For summer; Sun tan lotion, sun hat.
11. For winter; Ice scraper, de-icer, warm hat, gloves, high grip shoe chains, broom for clearing snow from the top of your car.

Storage should be securely fastened in your vehicle.
